COVID-19 Mitigation Plan

The Alaska Municipal League Joint Insurance Association (AMLJIA) is hard at work ensuring a safe and educational conference experience in Anchorage, Alaska on April 4-7, 2022. This means monitoring the status of COVID-19 cases in the area, guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and state and local mandates and policies. Currently, there are no COVID-19 mandates issued for the Anchorage Municipality.

The AMLJIA is committed to hosting a safe event for all participants, and we will continue to adapt our health and safety measures on an ongoing basis to provide as safe an environment as possible for our audience and speakers.

AMLJIA is implementing the following health and safety protocols:

- **Symptom-Free Protocol** requires all participants to stay home, or in their hotel room, if they experience any signs or symptoms of illness.
- **Face Coverings** are recommended for all participants. Although there is no mask mandate for the Anchorage Municipality, we are asking our participants to don a mask during conference sessions. Speakers have the option to remove their masks during their presentation.
- **Physical Distancing** measures will be in place at all gathering spaces and events, including placing seats in the conference rooms 3-feet apart (following CDC's guidelines for classroom seating).
- **Event Space Mitigations** include regular cleaning of shared conference rooms, hand sanitizer available at our booth and at conference tables, and disposable masks available at our booth.

Please do not attend this in-person event if you have experienced symptoms such as: fever, fatigue, difficulty breathing, dry cough or other symptoms related to COVID-19 within 48 hours prior to your scheduled arrival.

We ask our participants to be respectful of others space, health and safety while attending our event.
